Club Highlight



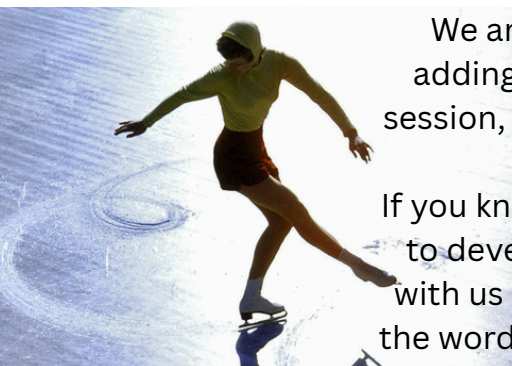
Thanks to many hands on deck, our first annual 4th of July parade float was a big success. We were so proud to represent HMFSC, and we are busy making big plans for 2026!
