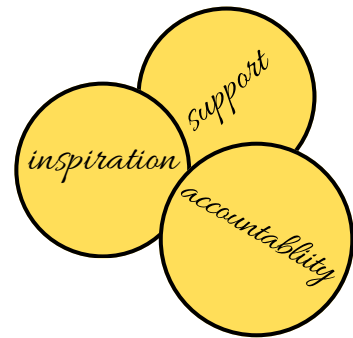


HMFSC April 2025 Newsletter
