TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reflection from Fr. Bernard Doré

Today's Gospel speaks of the personal experience and the Profession of the Faith of the first Pope St. Peter, in the following words "You are the Christ the Son of the living God."

In the First Reading, the master of the palace is told that he will be replaced. In his Letter to the Romans, St. Paul exhorts the Romans to give glory to God forever.

In the Gospel, St. Peter at last recognizes in Jesus the long-awaited Messiah. Jesus assures him that he did so only with the help of the Father. And at once, Jesus promises to found his church, and to give it into the charge of Peter. "You are rock, and on this rock I will build my church." In the Greek, the word rock and the word Peter are one and the same. Simon's new name is Peter that is rock.

We have here a twofold revelation which underlies our Catholic faith. The God-man will build a Church and he will build it on Peter. First, The Church and the papacy originated from God. Secondly, God is the original lawgiver, and the source of all just laws both in the Church and all human society. Thirdly, the role of the Pope is to help us know the mind and heart of Christ. It is not easy, as St. Paul indicates, but he says to the Philippians, "Have this mind in you which is also in Christ Jesus." Certainly, Christ's promise to Peter gives assurance he will help Peter to know his mind as far as Peter must to do Christ's work. The Pope has to study, pray for the Spirit's guidance, and consult the revelation and the tradition and the Living Church. Only then he can make his pronouncements.

Today let us sincerely pray for the Pope that he guides Christ's Church faithfully.

Lord, your love is eternal; do not forsake the work of your hands
