## SURGICAL SAFETY CHECKLIST

## Before induction of anaesthesia

- **Confirm identity, site and procedure**
- Consent form signed
- The medical history is up to date
  - Allergy?
  - Antibiotic prophylaxis?
  - Bleeding risk?
  - Airway or aspiration risk?
- **Pulse oximeter**
- Oxygen if needed
- Armamentarium checklist complete
- **Display:** 

  - **Implant planning report**
  - The clinical photos
- Pre-operative 0.2% CHX rinse

## **Before incision**

- **Confirm identity, site and procedure**
- Anticipated critical events:
  - Are there any patient-specific risks?
  - How long will the case take?
  - Contingency surgical plans? (e.g. different implant sizes, graft and
    - membranes on stand-by)
- Profound anaesthesia
  - **Topical anaesthetic**
  - Local anaesthetic
- Mark the incision site

This checklist is not intended to be comprehensive. Additions and modifications to fit local practice are encouraged.



- Instruments, implant components and needle count
- Sharp disposal
- Check for primary closure
- Hemostasis
- **Communicate the key concerns for** recovery and management:
  - With the team
  - Patient and the carer
- Written post-op instructions
- Post-op care pack (sterile gauze,
  - emergency contact details)
- Arrange a follow-up appointment

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
