Krista is a popular teacher across Canada and overseas who has exhibited at Quilt Canada and QuiltCon. This is an opportunity to take a class from an experienced modern quiltmaker at a small fraction of what it would cost you to attend QuiltCon. All events take place in our regular meeting room at Riverview Community Centre, 90 Ashland Ave.

Introduce your friends to Winnipeg's modern quilting scene from 7 to 9:30 p.m., Friday, Jan. 11. It begins with a lecture and mini trunk show by our guest speaker Krista Hennebury titled: "Poppyprint: The Search for Signature Style." Hennebury will speak on her start in traditional quiltmaking techniques and what influenced her gradual shift to modern quilting. She will break down the steps with quilts and photos of how quilters can discover what they like and how to incorporate outside influences in their work. All members present on the evening are eligible for the door prize draw of a set of LDH sewing shears.

We will have time for sewing after the meeting. Refreshments will be served. Please bring your own coffee cup. Admission is free for members, \$10 for guests.
