Saturday, April 27 Embrace the Chaos: An Exercise in Controlled Randomness

Using only paper and pencils, Libs will walk students through a series of worksheet exercises that mimic the programming language she uses to generate her quilt patterns. By using controlled elements in a random way, each participant will end up with a unique quilt pattern layout. Students will cut fabrics and piece designs using provided block-building instructions. At

the end of the class, each participant will leave with their own random geometric quilt design and will have the knowledge required to complete the project at home.



Sunday, April 28 The Weight of Love

This pattern is made up of hex, half-hex, and equilateral triangle pieces and was designed randomly using processing code. Students spend the day making the Weight of Love their very own by customizing it with a selection of solids and prints, and building it using the Y-seam piecing method. All participants will get a good start on the project and leave the class with the knowledge to complete the quilt at home. *Level: Intermediate*
