SWAPPING POUCHES: There's still time to make a pouch for our swap. Make a pouch in any style or pattern, measuring at least 6 by 10 inches, put your name inside on a slip of paper, and wrap the whole thing in paper or fabric. All pouches will be placed in a large bag, and members participating will pull a pouch blindly from the bag. Everyone participating is eligible to win a fabric bundle from The Fabric Curator, a new Canadian online store. If you can't attend but will still like to swap, please arrange for a friend to bring your pouch.

MORSE CODE AND MODERN QUILTING: Pat Daniels will talk about her design for our first group quilt. We plan to send it to QuiltCon in February as part of the guild charity quilt challenge. Pat is using the theme of text to design a quilt spelling

out Save our Planet in Morse code. It's an exciting design that incorporates patchwork and applique blocks from many participants, so please consider adding your piece to this project.
