

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Do students wear uniform every day? How do we get the uniforms?

We wear uniform Mon-Thurs. They must be purchased at In Unison Apparel which is located at 2085 N University Drive, Sunrise, FL 33322.

2. Does ELMA provide transportation?

We can provide transportation to families whose homes are two miles away or further from campus and are located between Sunrise Blvd and the Palm Beach County line.

Once you've secured a seat through the magnet application process, parents should secure a bus through <https://www.browardschools.com/register2ride>.

3. Will my child have to exercise?

Yes, physical training is integrated into the curriculum. It is generally done outdoors, once every other week.

4. What does ELMA look for in students?

Because we build college courses into our 9<sup>th</sup> graders' schedules, we look at students' academic history and test scores. Students whose FSA levels are 4 and 5 that mostly earn A's and B's have shown to be best equipped to handle the academic rigor.

5. How is ELMA different from JROTC?

ELMA is a college preparatory program that requires students to take JROTC. JROTC is an elective course that focuses on citizenship.

6. I think ELMA will be great for my child. Can I enroll him/her even if he/she does not want to?

Yes, but we recommend against that. Students that do well in ELMA choose to enroll because they see its benefits.
