As a Cadet of the Entrepreneur and Leadership Military Academy (ELMA), I,

agree to:

- Strictly adhere to the ELMA Academic and Moral Standards: cheating, stealing, destroying property, bullying and fighting are cause for dismissal
- Learn Academy Standards and abide by them
- Avoid tobacco, alcohol, and drugs. I understand non-avoidance is grounds for immediate dismissal. This is a one strike and you are out contract rule.
- Demonstrate respect and courtesy to all staff, faculty, Cadet leadership and fellow
 Cadets at all times
- Refrain from intimidating, harassing, or threatening others
- Exhibit good leadership, citizenship, sportsmanship and scholarship
- Wear ELMA uniforms with pride and according to standards
- Replace ELMA uniform(s) and/or associated items due to wear, loss or negligence
- Remain orderly and focused on task in the classroom
- Be responsible for completing and turning-in class work and homework
- Move from one area of the school to another in an orderly manner. Arrive on time to all classes prepared to lead / participate in classroom procedures
- Care for textbooks, furniture, equipment and rooms, leaving them unmarked and in as good a condition as they were found
- Understand my behavior at all other locations off school property reflects on the Academy (bus stop, bus, field trips, after-school activities, etc.). Accordingly, I will maintain the same standards of behavior expected while at school.
