School Uniform

- The gray polo-style shirt is worn tucked-in to pants that are entirely black
- The uniform can be worn with or without an undershirt; when an undershirt is worn it must be white, no other color is permitted
- Black pants are worn on the waist with a belt that is entirely black
- Leggings, jeggings, jeans and sweatpants are not permitted
- Entirely black, calf-length or crew-length socks are worn; no ankle socks
- Shoes must be entirely black (logos, soles, eyelets, laces, stitching, etc)









School Uniform

- There are only two jackets that may be worn with the School uniform
- When a jacket is worn, it is worn closed
- When the temperature is 65 degrees and below, a black or gray sweatshirt may be worn underneath the jacket
