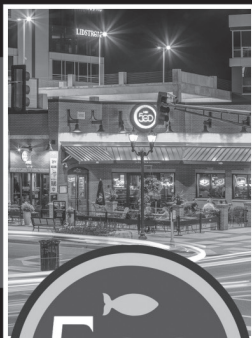

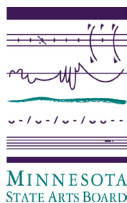

Cast Bios



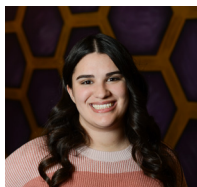
