DIRECTOR'S NOTE

In 1999, I decided to 'walk the boards' after more than 20 years since my previous acting experiences. I was cast as Father in the Merely Players production of "Children of Eden." The music and storyline gripped each and every one of the cast, crew, and audience members very much. So, when I was offered the opportunity to direct this junior version, I did not hesitate. And when David suggested that I could cast myself as Father, I was very excited to step back inside that world of Eden, the wasteland, and aboard the ark.

Through his music and lyrics, Stephen Schwartz (You may be familiar with some of his other work: Godspell, Pippen, Wicked, Pocahontas, etc.) enthralls you with the whole breadth of emotions...happiness, wonder, fear, anger, despair, hope, and forgiveness.

There are a lot of parenting aspects throughout this play. I see the theme of Children of Eden as being that of making choices. Choices made by the parents and by the children do not always go the way they were intended. When a choice is made, there will be consequences whether good or bad, possibly resulting in elation or pain. As parents, there comes a point when we no longer control the choices made by our offspring. We can guide and advise, but as Noah sings, "The hardest part of love is the letting go." Along the line of choice, I am particularly moved by Father's words which I believe offer hope to a sinful world, when He sings, "There is no journey gone so far-so far we cannot stop and change directions."

You are going to be witness to the results of a lot of hard work by these young people. I am sure you will be impressed by the multitude of talents that they have on display for you. It has been a total pleasure working with each and every one of the cast and crew while putting this play together!

You made a choice to be here today. Rest assured, it was a great choice! It is my wish that you too, will be emotionally drawn in, after all, we are all Children of Eden!


