commissioned by Knott's-Berry Farms in 1992 to write and direct a Festhaus show for the grand opening of the Mall of America. Kevin wrote and produced 16 shows for the Cabaret Club at the Albert Lea Inn for a five year run, and also proudly survived four years of traveling on cruise ships performing and touring the world. Aside from stage performances, additional creative work has been published in two books, *Photo-pedia*, and *Music Composition for Idiots*. He currently enjoys teaching music and drama at Waconia H.S., North H.S. and Chanhassen Dinner Theater.



#### Katherine Jardon (Music Director)




