

## Free Park Day!

Washington State Parks and the Washington Departments of Fish & Wildlife (WDFW) and Natural Resources (DNR) offer several "free days" when a Discover Pass is not required to visit these lands.

> June 19th --Juneteenth

Free days apply only to day use (not overnight stays or rented facilities). Free days are valid at state parks and Washington State Departments of Natural Resources and Fish & Wildlife lands. Sno-Park permits are still required on free days at designated Sno-Parks during the winter season.





The next full Moon will be Friday evening, June 21, 2024, appearing at 6:08 PM. The Moon will appear full for about three days around this time, from Thursday evening through Sunday morning.

In the 1930s the Maine Farmer's Almanac began publishing "Indian" names for full Moons and these names are now widely known and used. According to this Almanac, as the full Moon in June this is the Strawberry Moon, a name that comes from the relatively short season for harvesting strawberries in the north-eastern United States.

If you're not allergic, enjoy the strawberries, flowers, and honey during this "sweetest" month of the year, and take note of how low in the sky this full Moon will be.

As summer begins the daily periods of sunlight start to gradually shorten, having been at their longest on the summer solstice on the day before this full Moon. On the day of the full Moon, morning twilight will begin at 4:30 AM, sunrise will be at 5:43 AM, sunset will be at 8:37 PM

This full moon happens on the day after the Summer Solstice, June 20th, 2024, the longest day of the year; full moons occur within a day of the solstices about every 19 to 20 years.
