Once the initial fires were completed inside the house, the house was allowed to be completely burned down with the proper state permits that had been filed in the previous months.

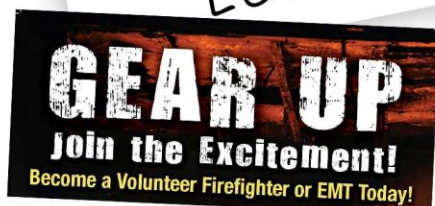
