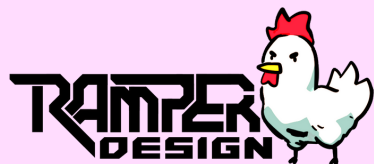

REGISTRATION FEE:

-25€-

The price is for the Championship entry only. This will give the players priority for the rest of the event's activities. All players registered will receive a "Player Tournament Pack" with promotional material.

THE HOTEL:

Playa Mar & SPA in Puerto de Pollença, Mallorca. A fantastic 4-star hotel with a SPA.

Prices, all inclusive:

Double 65€ - Price per person/night, one room for two adults.

Single 98€ - Price per person/night, one room for one adult.

Triple 60€ - Price per person/night, one room for three adults.

Children 30€ - Price per person/night, accompanied by up to two adults

Hotel details:

- Additional nights: You can extend your stay and take advantage of the offer, but the hotel opens on Thursday, February 13th. Therefore, rooms cannot be booked before that date.
- Prices: All rooms are the same, price varies depending on the number of guests per room.
- Room occupancy: The max occupancy of the rooms is either 2 adults and 2 children or 3 adults.
- Food: The package is all inclusive. For those assisting from Friday to Sunday, lunch is not included on Friday, but it is included on Sunday.
- Children: Children under 2yo are free of charge, but they must sleep on the room's bed. For pricing purposes, 12yo or younger are considered children.
- Drinks: Drinks are part of the all inclusive package, that includes alcoholic beverages during the bar's opening hours.
- Ecotasa: The "ecotasa" is a fee not included in the price, it is charged by the government and varies every year depending on the visitors load on the island. It is usually about 3€ day/person. It is paid upon check-in.
- Identification: Please present your ID card or Passport upon Check-in.
- Check-out: The room must be vacated by 12:00 PM on Sunday (except for those extending their stay). Sunday's lunch is included.
- Room usage: The guests will be held responsible for any loss or damage to the hotel property caused by themselves, their guests or any person for whom they are responsible.
- Noise: Keep in mind it is a family hotel, try not to make noise past midnight as per local regulations.
- Additional amenities: The hotel features a SPA, supermarket, nursery, outdoor activities, etc.
- SPA: It is recommended to bring a large towel and a swimming cap (mandatory). If you don't have one, they are available for purchase at the hotel.
- Payment: The hotel reservation and the tournament inscription are paid separately.

TRANSPORTATION:

The organization will provide no transportation. Rent-a-car services, public transportation and shuttle services are available on the island and through the hotel for those interested.

IMPORTANT DATES:

- **Registration Period:** December 1st to December 31st, via a registration form.
- **Pre-Registration List:** January 1st - The form and payment information will be sent.
- **Registration Payment Deadline:** December 30th. After this date, players who have not paid will be moved to the bottom of the list, and waitlisted players will take their spots.
- **Hotel Payment Deadline:** January 30th.
- **Refund Deadline:** Registration fees are refundable only until February 1st, and hotel fees until February 5th. After these dates, no refunds will be issued.

EXTRA ACTIVITIES:

- **Kids activities:** There will be activities to entertain kids, so that parents can enjoy the hotel on their own for a while.
- **Games Library:** There will be available board games to enjoy for hours and game assistants to resolve any doubts about the games.
- **Fast Painting:** A staple activity of our events: one hour, one model and a bunch of prizes.
- **Takkure Live:** Various activities related to rugby. Join us!
- **Grand Final:** We broadcast and comment live on the grand final of the tournament.
- **Demos:** New RamPer Design games

Important:

QUALITY SCORE A TRY: If a player who performs the TRY action doesn't have more than one fatigue token (activated or not), does not face the roll and no enemy player is within 3". The coach may discard an individual play card to add one die to the roll.

- Player cap:

There are only 40 spots available. If demand is high enough, we will consider increasing the number of available entries.

GENERAL RULES:

- Teams and line-ups:


All the players of the teams that are currently in the store (Yamato, Teriomoprhs, Islanders, SIC and Dorikins) can be used.

- Material:

Coaches must bring all the necessary components to play the game. If you are missing some, you must notify the organization.

- Referees:

Tournament participants must have a basic understanding of the game's rules. The main goal of the referee team is to solve conflicts, answer particular questions and clarify confusing rules. If a referee witnesses a misplay, they will intervene immediately to correct it. If the consequences cannot be rectified, the referee will try to rewind the game action in favor of the player being adversely affected by the misplay. In every situation, the referee will have the last word and will decide how to better solve the situation.



Before the match can continue, players must wait for the referee's decision. The referee can provide a time extension if they deem it necessary. Once a question has been answered and both players are satisfied, the referee's decision becomes final, including any unforeseen consequence it might generate.

It would be preferable if any issue that might appear during a match could be resolved to the satisfaction of both players, but in every situation, the referee's word is final. Colusion is ilegal, players may not make an agreement that would result in a contradiction of event or game rules.

- Sportsmanship:

Participants are expected to behave in a friendly and polite way with, but not limited to, guests, participants and staff members at all times. If a participant is considered to behave inadequately, they might face a sanction or a disqualification. Disqualified players are not elegible for refunds.

- FairPlay and Exceptions:

We advocate for fair play and a friendly environment. Some actions may be within the rules, but still be contrary to theses principles. If a participant displays this kind of behaviour consistently, they might be banned from participating in future events. The organization reserves the right to forfeit a player's match if they are in no condition to play or show up late.

- Decorum:

The organization reserves the right to forfeit a player's match if they are in no condition to play, they might also face a sanction or a disqualification. No alcoholic drinks are allowed in the gaming room.

- Time Management:

Time management often generates issues amongst players. In order to help manage the round's time, the staff will periodically announce the time left in the round.

- 30 minutes into the match warning.
- 1h into the match warning.
- 15 minutes left.
- 5 minutes left.

- Tournament sheet:

The Players will have a sheet to keep track and report their game stats: number of tries scored, players who scored, injuries, critical rolls, etc. The tournament sheet must be submitted to the staff in order to report the match results.

- Prizes:

EVERY participant will receive a pack with goodies.

- Special Awards:

All players are elegible for these awards:

Bad fortune is after me - The player against whom more critical rolls were inflicted.

Horseshoe up the...- The player who obtains the most critical rolls.

Wooden cyberimplants - The player who places last.

Sawbones dearest - The player with the most injuries.

Prizes will be raffled among all participants.

OTHER ACTIVITIES:

- Fast Painting:

Date: Sunday, February 16, 2025.

- The staff will provide all participants with an assembled and primed Tackly model, they will have an hour to paint it. The staff will provide the participants with paints and brushes, but it is recommend to bring your own brushes.

Participants will be able to pick up their painted model after the awards ceremony and the winner will receive a trophy.

- Live Takkure:

The tournament is contactless. The players will carry ribbons known simply as tags around their waist, if one is removed by an opposing player, the defending player is considered to have been tackled. The winning team will be awarded a trophy.
