1	Solar charger + backup batteries

8	High-calorie food (jerky, nuts, MREs)

Nº	SHELTER-IN-PLACE EMERGENCY BOX CHECKLIST	
1	1 gallon of water per person per day (7-day supply)	
2	Non-perishable food (7-day supply)	
3	Manual can opener	
4	Baby food/formula (if needed)	
5	Pet food & water	
6	Flashlights (one per room or person)	
7	Headlamps or LED lanterns	
8	Extra batteries (multiple sizes)	
9	Solar-powered or hand-crank chargers	
10	Power banks for phones	
11	Backup power source (generator or battery station)	
12	NOAA emergency radio (battery/solar/crank)	
13	Printed local emergency contact numbers	
14	Extra pre-paid cell phone and charger	
15	Pen, notepad	
16	First aid kit (fully stocked)	
17	7-day supply of prescription medications	
18	Over-the-counter meds (pain relievers, cold/flu, allergy, etc.)	
19	Copies of health insurance and prescriptions	
20	Eyeglasses/contact lenses and solution

1	Hand sanitizer & disinfectant wipes	
2	Toilet paper, tissues, paper towels	
3	Trash bags (for waste disposal)	
4	Toothbrushes, toothpaste	
5	Soap, shampoo, deodorant	
6	Feminine hygiene products	
7	Diapers & wipes (if needed)	
8	Blankets, sleeping bags, or warm layers	
9	Face masks (N95 or better)	
10	Work gloves and basic tools	
11	Duct tape and plastic sheeting (for sealing windows/vents)	
12	Entertainment (books, cards, puzzles, games)	
13	Ear plugs (for sleeping in noisy environments)	
14	Emergency plan printed & shared	
15	ID cards, insurance policies, emergency contacts	
16	Spare keys (home, vehicle)	
17	Cash (small bills)	
18	Fire extinguisher (check expiration)	
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
