Uniform Policy

- Students should be dressed in full school uniform at all times. On the day of P.E., they should wear their P.E. uniform. Students are not allowed to wear any sportswear during their P.E. lessons other than their P.E. uniform (RIS shorts or skorts and T-shirts).
- For boys and girls, unusual hair colors or styles are unacceptable. It is required for girls to keep their hair tied back at all times.
- Nails should always be clean and well-trimmed. Nail polish is not allowed.
- On certain occasions, students are allowed to come to school out of uniform. An email is sent prior with full details about the event /trip. Great care should be given to what students wear; transparent, revealing, or short clothes are not permitted.
- Wearing any makeup, jewelry, and accessories is not allowed on campus.
- Extra school T-shirts and deodorant may be kept in the student's locker.

NB:

In case of not finding any of the uniform items available at the store, a signed note from the store manager should be submitted to the Stage Coordinator on the same day that the student comes to school wearing an out-of-uniform item. In this case, plain navy blue trousers or jackets are allowed.

A reminder of the following "Not Allowed Items"

- Tight-fitted, skinny, baggy, or low-waist clothing.
- Dirty or ripped uniform.
- Colorful hair bands/headscarves (the permitted colors are white or blue)
- Unusual haircuts
- Multiple ear piercings and dangly earrings (one stud is permitted).
- Facial piercing.
- Makeup and traces of makeup
- Nail Polish.
- Jewelry/accessories such as chokers,

bracelets, and rings (only a wristwatch is permitted).

- Extreme hairdos/Hair color.
- Tattoos or Hennah.
- Unusual haircuts, man-bun or ponytail.
