We understand Jesus as the incarnate World of God, born in human flesh. The first chapter of the Bible claims that every human being, is made in the image of God. Our faith isn't just an idea that exists solely in the realm of abstract thought. It's how we live and breathe. Our faith is revealed in our words and actions - by how we use our bodies and how we treat the bodies of others.

We don't embody our faith just as individuals, either, but as a community. In the waters of baptism, God knits us together as one in the mystical body of Christ in the world. That's what the Church is called to be, recognizing that in each of us is the power to do the work of God, but that also means that the way we serve God is by serving others. The way we love God is by loving each other.

If we truly believe that each person bears the image of God, that every human being is a sacred revelation of the divine, then we as the Church are called to work against anything that desecrates or denigrates that divine image. We are called to denounce the sins of racism and white supremacy. We are called to stand in solidarity with each other, working to defend and empower those who are rendered vulnerable and made into victims by people who refuse to acknowledge the image of God they bear. When the world refuses to see the inherent dignity of every human life, we are called to change the world.

Empowered by the Holy Spirit we work along aside each other to live the faith we embody. That's what it means to be the Church.

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Highlights of the April 20, 2021, Council Meeting

- •ILC's Payroll Protection Plan 2021 loan application/PPP 2020 loan forgiveness Kathy Linder advised that the 2020 PPP loan forgiveness papers were submitted, have been approved, and the loan has officially been forgiven. The 2021 loan application for \$29,345.00 has been given to United Missouri Bank (UMB) who will review and submit the papers to the Small Business Administration (SBA).
- •ELCA Open Door Program Open Door is a new ELCA grant program to help implement ministry ideas targeted at meeting new people during the post COVID time of re-gathering in physical spaces. Deborah Crawford will lead an idea brainstorming discussion with members of the Welcoming, Stewardship, Steering, Social Ministry, and other appropriate Committees. They will work on submitting a concrete, actionable outreach plan for ILC. If selected we will be eligible for a \$1,500 \$2,500 grant.
- •Administrative Assistant Hire As a result of Ter'Ranay accepting a new position Pastor Micah and the Personnel Committee have held interviews for the opening, and formally offered the position to Sunni Battin, who has accepted the offer. There will be a meet Sunni Battin article in an upcoming newsletter.
