Chapter 308-10A WAC – Data Sharing.**

**Adoption of:** Chapter 308-10A WAC – Data Sharing.

**Effective date:** These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing or on September 7, 2023.

**What are the agency’s reasons for adopting this rule?**

The Department is creating rules to clarify the new law SSB 5152 from the 2021 legislative session, specifically its data sharing practices.

**Summary of all public comments received on this rule proposal and the agency’s response to those comments:**

<b>Why is the proposed language removing access for commercial parking operators? Shouldn’t the original RCW language be retained in the proposed WAC.</b>	After reviewing the written and oral stakeholder feedback, DOL has decided to remove the provisions regarding restricting access to commercial parking operators.
<b>Will DOL be providing pre-approved and identified auditors who meet the qualifications set in WAC?</b>	We will identify auditors who meet the qualifications, however, we will not be providing their services.

Multiple written comments were submitted regarding this rule change and there was oral testimony. Each of the questions or comments received by the department are included in the summary above.

**Changes made to the proposed WAC as a result of public comment:**

DOL will be removing the provisions regarding access restriction for commercial parking operators.
