## JHH Executive Salaries and Union Dues

NNU has provided information that Johns Hopkins Executive Salaries increased between 40 and 110% between 2010 and 2014. We have not independently verified that information and are not challenging it. It is important to remember that these positions are not only responsible for The Johns Hopkins Hospital, they have 24/7 accountability to the JHH, Johns Hopkins Bayview, Sibley Memorial, Suburban Hospital Center, and All Children's Hospital. Many, if not all, also have roles that affect Johns Hopkins International, Johns Hopkins Community Physicians, and Johns Hopkins Homecare.

### **What do those increases actually mean for JHH Nurses?**

The total increase in salary over a four-year period is \$2,646,644.

If the average hourly wage for the 3200 nurses in a union at Johns Hopkins was \$38.59<sup>1</sup> and average union dues are 1.1 hours per pay period<sup>2</sup>, the total paid in union dues by JHH nurses would be \$3,531,756.

**Johns Hopkins Nurses will be paying nearly \$1 million more in union dues every single year than these executives' salaries increased in total over 4 years!**
