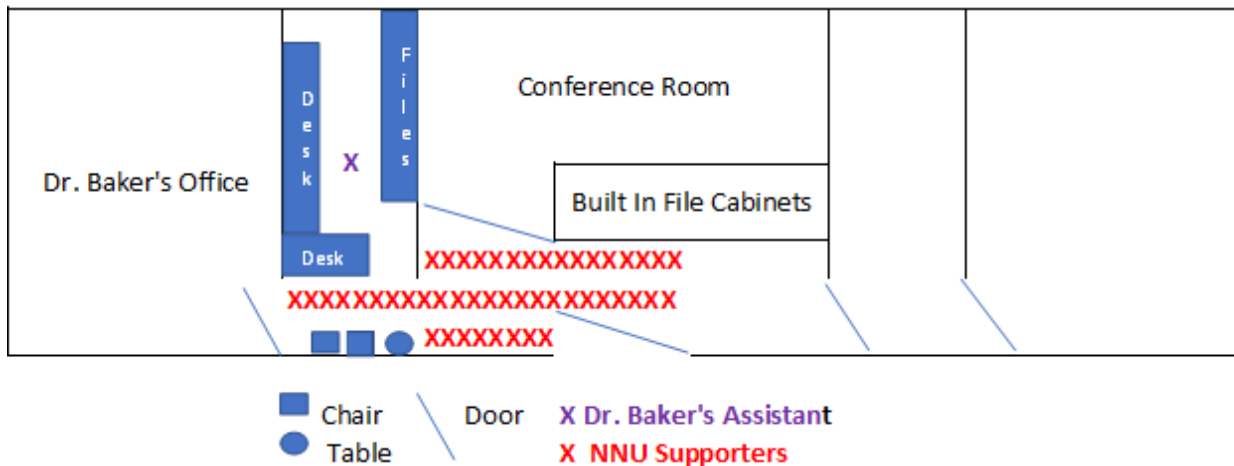
What are Your Values # 2?

Does This Behavior Represent You?

In NNUs most recent handout on dropping a “demand letter” to Deborah Baker’s office, they express “sympathy to Dr. Baker’s assistant, whose regular schedule was momentarily interrupted by our visit.”



This is a diagram of the layout of Dr. Baker's office. Imagine being Dr. Baker's assistant and being cornered with no escape route by 40+ people who, by their own comments, were there to make “demands.” In our society where practically weekly you hear of violence and shootings at schools and business and concerts, would you honestly just feel “interrupted” if you were Dr. Baker's assistant? Does this represent your values?
