Pass the Salt



- A salt is a person who gets a job with a specific workplace intentionally to organize a union
- Was Hopkins Salted?
 - Many of the initial internal organizers were here less than a year before starting organization efforts
 - Several of the vocal internal organizers have left or turned in their notice to leave Hopkins
 - Many nurses received a letter at home recently from a key internal organizer who is leaving Hopkins in spite of:
 - Saying, "I am a proud Hopkins nurse."
 - Referring to Hopkins administrators as "ours."
- If the focus were Hopkins nursing staff and patients, people would not get a job under false pretenses.
- Leaving after "stirring the pot," suggests the focus was only to push a union agenda.
