Policy and Procedure Committee

The policy and procedure committee will have the power to draft policies and procedures for the running of the club. All policies and procedures not outlined in other standing committees will fall under the direction of this committee. These include but are not limited to Code of Member Behavior, Communication, Physical Plan maintenance/upkeep/cleanliness, racing and regatta conduct, and illness and injury policy. This committee is a committee of the corporation, and will not have the ability to bind the board. Any policies and procedures must be submitted to and accepted by the board of directors. Once enacted, policies and procedures will be subject to review at the end of each spring season.

Safety Committee

The safety committee will have the power to draft policies and procedures for the safety of our rowers. Such policies and procedure include but are not limited to : Rower education, Rowing rules, Coach's Safety Pledge, Athlete's safety Pledge, Launch Operation and procedure, weather and Outdoor conditions and Personal Safety and Emergency procedures. This committee is a committee of the corporation, and will not have the ability to bind the board. Any policies and procedures must be submitted to and accepted by the board of directors. Once enacted, policies and procedures will be subject to review at the end of each spring season.

Financial Committee

The policy and procedure committee will have the power to draft policies and procedures for the financial well being of the club. Such policies and procedures include but are not limited to: Setting and Collection of Dues, Fundraising, Scholarship Funding and Disbursement, Budgeting, and Purchasing. This committee is a committee of the corporation, and will not have the ability to bind the board. Any policies and procedures must be submitted to and accepted by the board of directors. Once enacted, policies and procedures will be subject to review at the end of each spring season.

Membership Committee

The policy and procedure committee will have the power to draft policies and procedures for the running of the club as it pertains to managing and recruiting. Such policies and procedures include but are not limited to: volunteer requirements, Recruiting/Retention, Masters Program, Violation policies and Procedures, Academic and behavioral Standing , Guest Rower Program, Learn to Row Program. This committee is a committee of the corporation, and will not have the ability to bind the board. Any policies and procedures must be submitted to and accepted by the board of directors. Once enacted, policies and procedures will be subject to review at the end of each spring season.

SafeSport Committee

The SafeSport committee, also known in school system as DASA committee, shall have the power to draft and carry out policies and procedures concerning bullying, harassment and privacy issues. Such policies and procedures include but are not limited to: Coach training in US Rowing SafeSport, discrimination policy, handling of complaints and repercussions for violations. When needed this committee will check with Shen school system for validation of processes. This committee is a committee of the corporation, and will not have the ability to bind the board. Any policies and procedures must be submitted to and accepted by the board of directors. Once enacted, policies and procedures will be subject to review at the end of each spring season.
