

Maple Lake Township

Monthly Minutes

May 15, 2018

The regular meeting of the Maple Lake Township Board was called to order by Chairman Tom Neumann at 7:00 P. M. Supervisors, Ron Wolff, Tom Otto, Treasurer, Judy Neumann, and Clerk, Dick Hogan were present.

The minutes of the April 17, 2018 meeting was read by Chairman, Tom Neumann. Chairman Neumann noted that he had voted no on library contribution, and Reid garage approval. Clerk to correct, a motion was offered by Wolff, second by Otto to accept as read. Carried 3-0

David Bryant, 5599 County Road 12, noted he will sell additional acreage to allow more access on frontage for parcel he sold in 2016. No action taken, as transaction will not have a hearing.

Duane Rolfstad, developer, shared with the board, history of the old sewer plant, and road serving plant. He indicated that the land where plant sits, and the road are Township property. His goal is to have a road which would give access to lots which are ready for sale. There were other questions which the board were unable to provide answers. He was advised to meet with the City of Maple Lake. No action taken.

Liman Post & Beam requested a conditional use permit to allow expansion of the existing storage facility with a 44' X 120' mini storage building. Board noted zoning was correct and will conform with existing structures. Motion by Wolff, second by Otto to approve request to Wright County Planning & Zoning for consideration. Carried 3-0

Vernie Payne, 5246 Baker Ave NW; had questions about the flow of water and his property resulting from the improvements to the county ditch. Board was unable to give a concrete answers as future flowage will tell. No action taken.

All warrants were approved and paid as presented (see attachment)

As no additional business was brought before the board, Supervisor Tom Neumann adjourned meeting at 8:25 P. M.
