

Maple Lake Township

Monthly Minutes

June 19,, 2018

The regular meeting of the Maple Lake Township Board was called to order by Chairman Tom Neumann at 7:00 P. M. Supervisors, Ron Wolff, Tom Otto, Treasurer, Judy Neumann, and Clerk, Dick Hogan were present.

The minutes of the May 15, 2018 meeting was read by Chairman, Tom Neumann, as no additions or corrections were noted, a motion was offered by Otto, second by Wolff to accept as read. Carried 3-0

Jennifer Jorgenson, 3257 62nd Avenue NW: requested approval to remove an existing one story dwelling, and replace with a 2,500 sq ft. 2 story dwelling 75' from high water mark. Structure to be 9.3 feet from side property line, 37.9 from centerline of Town road. Variance to allow structure 19' from type IV septic system. Proposed structure under roof footage will put structure at 16.1% lot coverage. After review of proposed, board decided to view property before making any decisions.

Duane Rolstad, real estate developer, and Steve Huston, bank representative, discussed options for development of the former Stuhr property. No decisions were made, as more information will need to be made available.

Daniel Pribyl, 4237 County Road 37 NW: stated that he had contacted Town engineer in regard to partial road alteration of 58th street NW: which runs adjacent to his property and Lake Maple. Costs have not been developed because exact location of road alteration has not been determined. Mr. Pribyl is talking with property owners to resolve any problems.

Darek Vetsch, Wright County Commissioner, updated the board on his work to resolve County ditch maintenance costs and other problems. He also touched on other County activity, and answered questions from residents in attendance.

All warrants were approved and paid as presented (see attachment)

As no additional business was brought before the board, Chairman, Tom Neumann adjourned meeting at 8:35 P. M.
