

Maple Lake Township

Monthly Minutes

July 17, 2018

The regular meeting of the Maple Lake Township Board was called to order by Chairman Tom Neumann at 7:00 P. M. Supervisors Ron Wolff, Tom Otto, Treasurer Judy Neumann, and Clerk, Dick Hogan was present.

The minutes of the June 19, 2018 meeting was read by Chairman, Tom Neumann, as no additions or corrections were noted, a motion was offered by Wolff, second by Otto to accept as read. Carried 3-0

Chris Kline, Silver Creek Township supervisor, requested cost sharing with the replacement of a culvert on 90th Street, with an estimated cost of \$4,000. Motion by Neumann, second by Wolff to cost share on replacement project. Carried 3-0.

Robert Mueller, 1432 80th Street NW; requested approval of a conditional use permit for operation of a contractor's yard, with storage of material and equipment for exterior and gutter installation. Board questioned the hauling of large trucks, amount of traffic created. After review, a motion was offered by Wolff, second by Otto to approve. Carried 3-0.

Jaymes Littlejohn, representing The Veit Automotive Foundation, 8552 Baker Avenue NW; explained the purpose and the inner workings of the Foundation. Facility to have a car museum, with a retreat center setting. Question on traffic and parking did not appear to create any problems. Motion by Wolff, second by Otto to grant request. Carried 3-0.

Mark Buss, 4261 58th Street NW; discussed why lilacs and a portion of fence should be removed from road right-of-way. Board stated that they were a traffic visibility hindrance, and a maintenance problem. Also, yard light installed by neighbor that created a lighting issue had been removed. Other than requesting removal of lilacs and fence, no other action was taken.

Replacement of Maple Lake Township identity sign mounted on hall be removed because of aging, and replaced with an injected molded sign at a cost of \$1980.00. Motion by Neumann, second by Wolff to approve replacement, Carried 3-0.

Motion was offered by Otto, second by Wolff, to approve list of election judges available for August 14, 2018 primary election. Carried 3-0.

A motion was offered by Wolff, second by Otto to purchase additional tables for hall. Carried 3-0.

All warrants were approved and paid as presented (see attachment)

As no additional business was brought before the board, Chairman, Tom Neumann adjourned meeting at 8:50 P. M.
