

Minutes of the Special Board Meeting and Public Hearing July 7th, 2020, 4:00 PM Held at Maple Lake Township Hall

The special meeting of the Maple Lake Township Board was called to order by Chairman Tom Neumann at 4:00 PM.

Supervisors Greg Gindele and Tom Hackenmueller, Treasurer Judy Neumann and Clerk Esther Doran were present.

The board discussed that the township ran out of gravel before they could finish the roads. The Supervisors are looking into why the gravel ran out. They are also looking into where to buy gravel for next year.

Dust control was discussed. The board wasn't happy with Minnesota Dust Control because they aren't coming out here soon enough. One of the maintenance employees quit without notice and Tim the other full-time maintenance person is willing to help out more until a new grader operator is hired. The Board has decided to publish a hiring ad in the Buffalo Drummer and to post it on the township website.

Wright County Planning and Zoning emailed two requests that needed to be discussed. The first one was regarding an home owner who wanted an addition put on. The Supervisor's decided that due to the maximum coverage being increased, the board has decided to decline approval of the variance. The request from Vonco was to continue mining clay from a pit located in Maple Lake township. The Maple Lake Township Board approves the mining of the clay until the end of the calendar year 2021.

As no additional business was scheduled for the Special Meeting, a motion was offered by Neumann and seconded by Hackenmueller to adjourn the meeting at 5:55 PM. Motion carried 3 to 0.
