Monthly Minutes

March 19, 2019

The regular meeting of the Maple Lake Township Board was called to order by Clerk, Dick Hogan at 7:00 P. M. Supervisors, Tom Neumann, Greg Gindele, and Ronald Wolff, Treasurer, Judy Neumann were present.

The minutes of the February 19, 2019 meeting was read by Tom Neumann, as there were no additions or corrections, a motion was offered by Wolff, second by Gindele to accept as read. Carried 3-0

Motion by Wolff, second by Gindele to name Tom Neumann chairman of the board for the year of 2019. Carried 3-0

Opening of bids for hauling and spreading of gravel, and the application of dust control for the year of 2019 were the next order of business:

One bid was received for application of dust control submitted by Central Minnesota Dust Control, with cost of magnesium chloride @ 30%, \$.86 per gallon applied. Magnesium chloride @33% \$.90 per gallon applied. Motion by Wolff, second by Gindele to accept the bid of Central Minnesota Dust Control for the application in 2019. Carried 3-0.

Four bids for gravel hauling and spreading were received:

B. McNamara, Inc. \$7.68 loaded and hauled

Bjorklund Companies: \$3.80 hauled + loading \$.75 per yard.

Kolles Sand & Gravel: loading and hauling \$4.55 per yard.

M L Schendzielos & Son, Inc: \$5.00 loaded and hauled per yard.

Motion by Wolff, second by Gindele to accept the bid of Bjorklund Companies for loading and hauling in 2019. Carried 3-0.

Motion by Gindele, second by Wolff to publish agenda 10 days prior to monthly board meeting. Carried 3-0.

Matt Bronder, PID 216-000-102-200: 4906 Dempsey Avenue NW would like to split 21 acres off 73 acres for future building sites. No action taken by board.

Discussion centered around the hiring of part-time or full-time maintenance employment. It was decided a special meeting of the board should be published for discussion on wage range, benefits, and job skills. Tentative date of Tuesday, March 26, was set.

All warrants were paid as presented (see attachments).

As no additional business was brought before the board, Chair Neumann offered a motion to adjourn at 8:40 PM; second by Wolff Carried 3-0.
