We all love heroes like Spiderman, Superman, James Bond, Batman and a host of others. But all of them have been straight although who knows what goes on between Batman and Robin down in the bat cave.. Now we have a hero gay boys can call their own. Meet Jayms Blonde. He is a hairdresser by trade and a secret agent by choice. Along with his faithful pedicurist, Precious Needmore, he leads the fight to save our planet from bad air and even bad hair. As an agent of STOP (Stop Terrorizing Our Planet) he is pitted against his arch nemesis in the ZENRON Corp (Zillionaire Environmental Nihilist Reinstating Oligarchy Nobility OR Zealous Environmental Nazis, Ruthlessly Obliterating Nature) with his cache of deadly cosmetic products, never ending puns and a sexual libido running in overdrive.

And what a collection of super gadgets he has at his disposal to aid in the fight. The other James would be jealous wishing he also had a Uzi blow-dryer firing Teflon bullets, hair-curler-hand-grenades, explosive press-on nails and bulletproof hair mousse. Better still is the backpack that sprouts wings enabling Jayms to fly around like a very handsome, very sexy bumblebee (ahem!).

Set in Hawaii and Hong Kong, the action is furious and the bodies pile up and not only in Jayms bed. This is an entertaining satire of the Bond novels that is cartoon-like in so many ways and in fact includes cartoon panels every few pages that would be right at home in Superhero comics. And of course the villains are dumb evil capitalists and the CIA guys are clueless as usual in these stories.

Many of the characters have delicious double entendre names like Hung Lo, Harri Kummalot, Barry Cuda, Hugh Humpit and Lucky Lai to name just a few. Between action scenes, Jayms is always up for sex with the other hot guys around him and he always gets his man. While there are numerous such scenes, they are strongly hinted at but never detailed or X-rated.

By now, you probably realize that nothing about this book is subtle but that makes it all the more fun to read. It gets wilder by the page as Mama dishes out assignments to Jamys who does battle with Zaroya and her evil henchmen and women as she plots to assassinate Miss Galaxy, force Pakistan and India into war, and of course ruin the environment by destroying corn products.

The Hair-Raising Adventures of Jayms Blonde is one wild ride into a gay world where everyone seems to be gay and the frizzy tale gallops along at a dizzying pace as Jayms, a former U.S. Navy Seal, leads his pink band of handsome gays against the forces of evil who put profit over nature.
