After the Performance of the Score of Dragon Myth, the great lyricist Sheldon Harnick came up to me and introduced himself and congratulated me on my music. That is a moment I can never forget.

He was working on a new project that involved Dragons and wanted to see how we used them in out show. It was the begining of an ongoing aquantance that would lead to Sheldon Harnick to attend three of my musicals including the opening night of Pretty Faces Off-Broadway and as a guest at our opening night party.

That night I also recieved a note from Stephen Sondheim and representation from an established NY literary Agency.


