FIRST ANNUAL "NEW YORK MUSICAL THEATRE FESTIVAL" SEPT 13th - OCT 3rd, 2004

The New York Musical Theatre Festival (NYMF) will do for musical theatre what Sundance does for independent film: celebrate its diversity, creativity and future. Running September 13 – October 3, 2004 in New York City, the Festival is presented by Time Out New York (weekly media partner) and AM New York, Theatermania and HX Magazine. Centered in the heart of the Theatre District and dedicated to discovering new works, new artists and creating new stars, the festival will run over 21 days in 19 different venues, featuring over 65 different productions with 280 performances and almost 1000 performers and musicians. The New York Musical Theatre Festival is predicted to be the largest musical theatre event in New York City.

A total of 31 premiering musicals will be staged during NYMF. These productions include a series of 15 new musicals just spreading their wings in "The Next Link Project" and a half dozen international and American works "Invited Productions" featured in the Festival, from over 220 international submissions. "Shout" from England, "Top Gun" and "Frankenstein, Do You Dream?" from Toronto Canada, "As You Like It" from Australia, "Lulu" straight from the New York Fringe Festival, and "Pretty Faces", the only American regional theater production among the "Invited productions", from ACE Theater of Oregon's 2004 January-February Production.
