Gazebo Golden Ale (5.4%) \$3/4/6

- Clean malt profile, balanced with mild German hops. Good ole beer flavored beer.
- Named for the gazebo on the Town Square. The same gazebo featured on our logo and mural.

Pickwick Pale Ale (6.0%) \$3/4/6

- A delicious pale ale malt balanced with fruity hops. A blend of Cascade, Citra and Nectaron hops.
- Named for everyone's favorite lake destination and the lake our owner grew up skiing on - Pickwick Lake. A lot of Memphians knew of Collierville growing up as the town you passed through on your way down highway 57 to Pickwick.

Maggie's Pub Ale (4.7%) \$3.50/5/7

- A flavorful, balanced session beer at 4.7% ABV. Moderate maltiness with light bitterness from EKG & Fuggle hops.
- Named for our owner/brewer, Maggie, due to her red hair and Irish heritage.

West Poplar Porter (7.4%) \$3.50/5/7 *NITRO SERVE*

- Medium-bodied dark beer with notes of coffee and undernotes of chocolate. Creaminess from nitro serve. Deceptively drinkable.
- Named for the street for which we call home.

Mayor Maureen's Maibock (8.3%) \$4/6/8

- A German-style bock beer, originated in Munich in the 18th century. The name "Maibock" translates to "May beer" in German, reflecting its traditional consumption during the spring season. Brewed over the late winter and lagered until an early spring release.
- Named for Collierville Mayor Maureen Fraser. We love to celebrate great women in leadership, and MM is an excellent example.
