Gazebo Golden Ale (5.4%) \$3/4/6

- Clean malt profile, balanced with mild German hops. Good ole beer flavored beer.
- Named for the gazebo on the Town Square. The same gazebo featured on our logo and mural.

Abbington Amber Ale (6.4%) \$3.50/5/7

- A medium-bodied Amber Ale with a beautiful copper color. Hopped with Rakau & Idaho 7.
- Named for Abbington Street, directly across from the brewery.

Water Tower Wheat (4.9%) \$3/4/6

- A light, golden wheat ale. Crisp, refreshing, and a fan favorite in the Taproom.
- Named for our famous Collierville Water Tower that stands proudly over the town square.

Lecile's Milk Stout (5%) \$4/6/8 *NITRO SERVE*

- Dark, malty, stouty goodness. Coffee and nutty notes. Served on nitro, so it has a beautiful, creamy taste.
- Named for Collierville's own Lecile Harris. A world-famous rodeo clown who also starred in TV and film.

Mayor Maureen's Maibock (8.3%) \$4/6/8

- A German-style bock beer, originated in Munich in the 18th century. The name "Maibock" translates to "May beer" in German, reflecting its traditional consumption during the spring season.
- Named for Collierville Mayor Maureen Fraser. We love to celebrate great women in leadership, and MM is an excellent example.
