Bailey Station Belgian Ale (8.3%) \$4/6/8

- An 8.3% Belgian ale - mildly sweet, full-bodied taste with all the Belgian yeast flavors you love.
- Named for Bailey Station Road on the West side of town.

Pickwick Pale Ale (5.8%) \$3.50/5/7

- A delicious pale ale - malt balanced with fruity hops. A blend of Cascade, Citra and Nectaron hops.
- Named for everyone's favorite lake destination and the lake our owner grew up skiing on - Pickwick Lake. A lot of Memphians knew of Collierville growing up as the town you passed through on your way down Highway 57 to Pickwick.

East Powell Hazy IPA (6.7%) \$4/6/8

- An East Coast Hazy IPA. Fruity, tropical, citrus and juicy notes, all from the dry hop. Hopped with Amarillo, Citra and Galaxy.
- Named for East Powell Road. A nod to the east coast influence on this Hazy IPA.

Hewlett & Dunn Boot Brown Ale (4.7%) \$3.50/\$5/\$7

- A malty brown ale with notes of caramel and brown sugar. Balanced and smooth with English aroma hops.
- Shout out to Hewlett & Dunn on the Collierville Square. Your one-stop shop for clothing, gifts, boots and western wear.

Loni's Lemonade (NON-ALCOHOLIC, KID-APPROVED) \$2.50

- Non-alcoholic, house made sparkling lemonade with a tiny hint of lime.
- Named for our owner Maggie's daughter, Loni. 50 cents of each pour goes to a nonprofit of Loni's choice each month.

*Growler fills available on any beer (or lemonade), with the exception of any nitro beers. 32 or 64 oz fills. MBC growlers available for purchase (\$4.50/\$6.50) or we will fill any CLEAN 32/64 oz growlers.

*We fill an assortment of 16 oz cans for to go consumption weekly. Can prices are for single cans - \$4/4.50/5, depending on the beer.
