Here are **5 Torah-based witnessing points** designed for you to easily remember and use when sharing the truth about Yahweh, Yahshua, and the commandments. Each point includes short, memorable phrasing followed by a brief explanation for context and conversation.

Yahshua is the Living Word made flesh (John 1:14). He did not abolish the Torah but fulfilled it and taught us how to walk in it (Matthew 5:17–19). Through belief in Him, we are restored to covenant relationship with the Father and empowered to live righteously. John 14:6; Matthew 5:17–19; Romans 3:31	The Sabbath is a weekly sign between Yahweh and His people forever (Exodus 31:13–17). It's not merely rest from work, but a spiritual declaration of loyalty to our Creator. Yahshua Himself kept the Sabbath (Luke 4:16) as an example for all who follow Him. Genesis 2:2–3; Exodus 20:8–11; Luke 4:16	Yahweh's Feasts (Leviticus 23) reveal His plan for salvation: Passover points to Yahshua's sacrifice, Pentecost to the giving of the Spirit, and Tabernacles to His dwelling among us. These are not "Jewish holidays," but divine appointments for all believers. Leviticus 23; Zechariah 14:16–19; Colossians 2:16–17	The Torah defines love; love for Yahweh and love for others (Deuteronomy 6:5; Leviticus 19:18). Yahshua said, "If you love Me, keep My commandments" (John 14:15). Obedience is not about legalism but about living out covenant love daily. John 14:15; 1 John 5:2–3; Deuteronomy 30:19–20	We are called to live differently; to be holy as Yahweh is holy (Leviticus 20:26). Our lives, speech, and conduct are to reflect the Kingdom. By walking in truth and righteousness, we become living testimonies that draw others to the light. 1 Peter 1:15–16; Matthew 5:14–16; Romans 12:1–2
