

Dear Friends of Stinker:

The recent pet food recall by Menu Foods struck close to home. As you may know, 5 was diagnosed with hyperthyrodism in August 2006 and barely pulled through after s several days at the hospital. The veterinarian treating him at the time, Dr. Salt at VI Sepulvada Blod, in West Los Angeles, recommanded to Stinker's morn, Jan Des Rosier she switch his food to Nutro Max. A couple of weeks ago, Jan noticed that he wasn'l with his typical appetite, but she clidh't know why so she laft it out and eventually h finished it. Within days we found out that it was this food that was received.

Since the announcement, we've been very worried about Stinker. His thyroid condition have the same symptoms as the poisoning so it was difficult to tell what was wrong him. He has been more listless than normal, is still wornting quite a bit, and at times is seemed that he was drinking more water than normal...all signs of kidnay failure. How we thought it might also be that he needed more medication since he was vomiting in than normal, and his food had been changed suddenly several times, looking for a replacement, so that may have upset his little furny tummy.

When the recall happened, it was difficult to obtain information as the toll free hotlin setup by Menu Foods were ringing off the hook and hard to get through. When we fi did, they took Jan's information and actually did call back within 24 hours (!) saying were mailing out a reimbursement claim form for any veterinary bills. We're still waitin

We have good news! Stinker's test results showed no poisoning. It has been stress watching him struggle but now we think it is a combination of changing foods so muc along with a needed increase in medication. Thank you Dr. Weiss and the staff at VC hospital for taking care of Stinker!

Through our experiences as pet owners, StinkersFriends is standing champion a new cause: to raise money to assist the poor with the s costs of animal care.

We are deeply disturbed that Menu Foods offered reimbursement for expenses and the refused to pay it because they are now going to court in a class action lawsuit. We saddened they did not step up to the plate to work with local veterinarians to offer no-cost services to pet parents who were affected by the recal veterinarians to affer necessary care. Our organization wents to change how things like this are handled!
