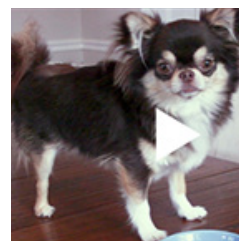

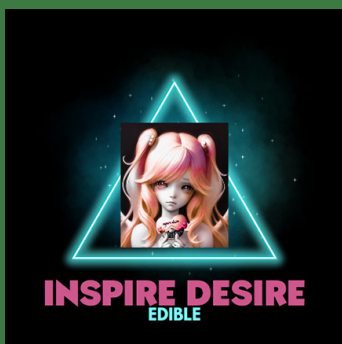

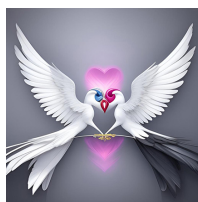

Pet Talk: Forms of Communication Verbal & Non-Verbal

Verbal: Scientists label human language verbal because of the use of creative symbols (such as alphabets and math signs) with advanced rational thought process.

Non-Verbal: Experts suggest there are four categories of animal non-verbal communication:

1. **VISUAL:** Shape and color; and special effects like glowing lightning bug.

2. **AUDIBLE:** Barks, growls, hisses, whines, purrs, rattles

3. **CHEMICAL:** Scents of those who mark territory or protect themselves like skinks.
