


Background & Purpose

Toward an Active California (2017)

Statewide Bike/Ped Plan

• Called for development of "District-level plans to identify bicyclist and pedestrian needs on or parallel to the SHS, with a focus on closing gaps and building complete, comfortable networks."



SAFETY

Reduce the number, rate, and severity of bicycle and pedestrian involved collisions

MOBILITY Increase walking and bicycling in California



PRESERVATION Maintain a high quality

active transportation system

SOCIAL EQUITY

Invest resources in communities that are most dependent on active transportation and transit



Background & Purpose

- Establish a method for identifying & evaluating bicycle and pedestrian location-based needs on or near the State Highway System.
- Create Statewide baseline to inform subsequent Caltrans processes.




