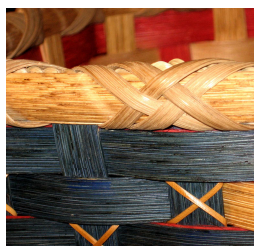
Flag Basket Class

Needed Items

New shoes for children

Belts, socks, underwear
Hand and body lotion (full size bottles)
Hand soap, Shampoo and Conditioner
Lice shampoo and spray (Rid Brand)
Reusable shopping bags, Clorox Wipes
Bar soap/body wash, Laundry detergent
Toilet paper, Kleenex, Combs and Hairbrushes
Feminine hygiene products
Glue sticks, Pocket folders, Crayons
Index cards, Colorful construction paper
