February 15th Guild Project

The February project is called Handy Caddy. It is a 10" x 5" x 4.5" high basket. There are several bases available on a first-come first-serve basis. Some are for silverware and napkins. Others, like the picture shows, have a section with holes to put tools in. The basket has a slotted bottom for flat spokes. It is a simple basket to weave. Everyone should be able to finish it. There will be several colors to choose from. There should be plenty of kits but there is a limited number of bases. Nineteen people signed up at the last guild meeting.

REED DYING WITH RIT DYES BY JANET NEWMAN

THERE IS A FILE ATTACHED TO THE NEWSLETTER THAT SHOWS FORMULAS FOR DYING ANYTHING WITH RIT DYE. I LIKE THIS SHEET BECAUSE IT LISTS THE AMOUNTS FOR POWDERED DYE AND FOR LIQUID DYE. THERE IS A FILE ONLINE AT RIT DYE THAT JUST LISTS THE AMOUNTS AND DOES NOT SAY LIQUID OR POWDER. I USE BOTH POWDER AND LIQUID DEPENDING ON WHAT I HAVE ON HAND OR CAN FIND IN THE STORES. THE ONLINE FILE HAS A PICTURE OF THE COLORS WHICH IS VERY HELPFUL. I WILL USE BOTH FILES. THERE ARE MANY WAYS TO DYE REED. I USE A BIG POT ON MY KITCHEN STOVE. ALL UTENSILS FOR DYEING NEED TO BE USED JUST FOR DYEING. ABOUT A CUP OF SALT IS ADDED TO THE DYE POT WITH THE DYE. THE WATER NEEDS TO BE HOT BUT NOT BOILING. THEN WHEN I RINSE, I USE WHITE VINEGAR. RECENTLY I HAVE STARTED USING RETAYNE TO SET THE DYE. RETAYNE IS A COMMERCIAL FABRIC COLOR FIXATIVE PRODUCT. IT IS A LITTLE EXPENSIVE BUT ONLY TAKES A VERY SMALL AMOUNT. IT IS GOOD TO PUT IN YOUR WATER TUB WHEN WEAVING. IT WILL SET THE DYE IN REED YOU HAVE BOUGHT AND DON'T KNOW THE COLORING PROCESS USED.
