SQUARE BANDANA BASKET KIT OR A SPIRAL,
TWILL BASKET KIT (8"X8"X7") WOVEN ON A 4"
SLOTTED BASE WITH A WIRE HANDLE WITH A
WOODEN GRIP. EACH KIT WILL COST \$20.

Helpful Reminders from the Guild

Guidelines for Guild Project Participation

Since the volunteers at the guild are not in the basket business, supplies must be purchased out of state and shipped. For this reason, teachers of basket projects need a good amount of time to order supplies and cut kits which means that folks need to order their kits ASAP and after the newsletter announces the project is not always enough time.

These guidelines will help our teachers plan and prep for your baskets.

1. Lorraine, our newsletter lady will provide a flyer by the end of Feb. that describes all the projects for the year.

You may use the flyer to see the dates of each project and thus, sign-up in advance and pay.

2. Payment is requested in advance due to the large number of members and the cost our teachers incur. *You should sign up and pay for kits at the meeting prior to the designated project.*

3. If you miss a meeting, then it is your responsibility to sign-up and pay by mail in advance of the newsletter for that project's month.

PRESIDENT'S CORNER

AS THE CONTINUING PRESIDENT OF THE GUILD, I WOULD LIKE TO START BACK WITH HAVING INFORMATION IN EACH NEWSLETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT. MY MANY ORTHOPEDIC SURGERIES AND HEALTH ISSUES HAVE REALLY SLOWED ME DOWN. I HAVE SOLD MY BASKET INVENTORY TO A FELLOW WEAVER SO WILL NO LONGER HAVE REED AND OTHER ITEMS TO SELL. THAT SAID, I WILL STILL BE OFFERING THE LAST SATURDAY WEAVIN ON THE LAST SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH IN WHEATLAND, OK.

WE HAD ELEVEN PEOPLE COME TO THE LAST SATURDAY WEAVIN THIS PAST SATURDAY. IT SURE WAS A COLD DAY TO GET OUT. THERE WERE FOUR BRAND NEW WEAVERS WHO KEPT ME HOPPING. THEY ALL WOVE THE BEGINNER NAPKIN BASKET AND ALL WENT HOME WITH A FINISHED BASKET. I THINK 2 OF THEM WILL COME TO THE FEBRUARY GUILD MEETING. WE ALSO HAD 2 MEN AT THE MEETING. IT IS ALWAYS GREAT TO SEE MEN COME TO ANY WEAVING EVENT.

THE TEXAS RETREAT WAS THIS PAST WEEK. IT WAS VERY INTERESTING WITH THE ELEMENT OF THE WEATHER. DO WE STAY EXTRA DAYS OR DO WE BRAVE IT AND HEAD HOME WAS THE TOPIC THE LAST FEW DAYS. IT WAS A GREAT TIME WITH OLD AND NEW FRIENDS AND ALL THE CLASSES WERE FANTASTIC.

THE SILENT AUCTION AND OPPORTUNITY DRAWING (RAFFLE) WERE GREAT FUN. THERE WAS A NANTUCKET KIT IN THE SILENT AUCTION THAT I REALLY WANTED AND KEPT UPPING MY BID. I'M GLAD TO SAY THAT I GOT THAT KIT. IT IS A SMALL PICNIC BASKET BY NATHAN TAYLOR. NOW I JUST HAVE TO FIND THE MOLD.

YOUR GUILD'S BOARD MET IN JANUARY AND WE ACCOMPLISHED A LOT AND WILL IMPLEMENT SOME NEW THINGS THAT WILL HELP MAKE THE GUILD MEETINGS RUN SMOOTHER. THE FIRST THING YOU WILL NOTICE IS KITS WILL BE HANDED OUT AS USUAL. ONLY THING DIFFERENT HERE WILL BE THE PATTERN WILL NOT BE HANDED OUT UNTIL THE TEACHER HAS HAD A CHANCE TO TALK AND DEMONSTRATE HOW TO START AND WEAVE THE BASKET. THIS WILL SLOW THINGS DOWN A LITTLE BUT WILL GREATLY HELP PEOPLE UNDERSTAND HOW TO GET THEIR BASKET STARTED AND FINISHED. IT IS IMPORTANT TO BE ABLE TO GET YOUR BASKET FINISHED AT THE GUILD MEETINGS BECAUSE MOST OF THE BASKET PROJECTS FOR THIS YEAR WILL HAVE DIFFERENT RIMS THAN THE STANDARD FLAT OVAL INSIDE AND OUT AND LASHED WITH SEAGRASS.

ANOTHER THING YOU WILL NOTICE IS THE OFFICERS AND BOARD MEMBERS WILL BE ROAMING AROUND WATCHING FOR PEOPLE STRUGGLING WITH THE WEAVING TECHNIQUES. PLEASE LISTEN TO THESE PEOPLE WHO MAY HAVE AN EASIER WAY FOR YOU TO WEAVE INSTEAD OF WHAT YOU ARE USE TO. I WILL ALSO SAY THAT THERE ARE MANY WAYS TO DO SOME OF THE WEAVING TECHNIQUES. SO DON'T GET UPSET IF SOMEONE SHOWS YOU SOMETHING DIFFERENT. JUST TUCK IT AWAY AND KNOW THAT FOR SOME BASKETS IT EASIER ONE WAY AND BETTER ANOTHER WAY IN THE NEXT BASKET. WE ARE STILL TRYING TO CATCH UP ON TEACHING BASKET TECHNIQUES TO ALL THE NEW PEOPLE WHO STARTED WEAVING SINCE COVID. IF YOU HAVE ANY IDEAS HOW TO HELP THIS, PLEASE LET US KNOW.

SPEAKING OF IDEAS AND TEACHING, WE ARE LOOKING FOR NEW PEOPLE TO BECOME TEACHERS. AS YOU CAN SEE, OUR GUILD IS AGING OUT. OUR TEACHERS ARE LESS AND LESS. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO LEARN TO TEACH A BASKET CLASS, PLEASE TALK TO ONE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS OR OFFICERS. WE WILL HELP YOU PICK OUT A BASKET, OBTAIN THE MATERIALS, CUT THE KITS, AND TEACH IT. YOU WOULD HAVE SUPPORT ALL ALONG THE WAY AND GAIN A NEW SKILL. YOU MIGHT EVEN MAKE SOME MONEY FOR YOURSELF. IT IS A WONDERFUL FEELING TO SEE PEOPLE FINISH SOMETHING YOU STARTED. BEING TOO BUSY IS NOT A GOOD EXCUSE TO NOT TEACH. WE ARE ALL BUSY BUT WE ARE HERE TO HELP.

BE SURE TO NOTE THE DATES FOR THIS YEAR'S GUILD MEETINGS. SOME OF THE DATES ARE THE SECOND SATURDAY AND SOME ARE THE THIRD. OUR DECEMBER CHRISTMAS PARTY HAS BEEN MOVED TO NOVEMBER 21 FOR THIS YEAR. TALK ABOUT EARLY. THAT IS BEFORE THANKSGIVING. OH WELL, IT IS WHAT IT IS.


