Same size weavers and spokes are easier to weave if more space is added between the spokes. From Janell Hopkins

Cherokee Double Wall is easier to start by using one size smaller RR than you are planning to use for the basket. Marcia Balleweg

Fillers – weave the center spoke – add the fillers – if at all possible (odd number of spokes) end with the filler on top of the last spoke – cut so that when the basket shifts the filler will still be on top. – From a Chinese basket

Matching fabric to reed color can be fun. Use diluted water colors to brush onto the reed. From 1^{st} Monday Weavers, Tulsa – Judy Stone

Dimensions: 7x7x3"

Spokes, 5/8'' Weavers and rim, $\frac{1}{2}''$ Retaining row and lasher, 3/16'' FO All spokes will be the same length.

All Guild members with their expert weaving skills will be needed to help the beginning weavers. Bring your tools and weights to share. I have asked some of the confirmed registrants to bring a few items. I have sent the e-mail cards that we received from people interested in taking the class. 
