Dimensions: 15" X 12" w/o handle



Color Choices from left to right: Cornucopia, Evergreen, Confetti.

Cornucopia is a space dyed combination of gold, cocoa and paprika.

Evergreen is space dyed with dark green, jade green and turquoise.

Confetti is my name for have fun with color. This choice will have natural stakes and a variety of dyed reed in different sizes.
