

FEATURE

Alton Maltings is one of only a few buildings left from Alton's brewing history and is now a Listed Building.

In the late 1990's it lay semi-derelict when Harvest Church (Alton Evangelical Free Church at the time) was approached about whether it could meet their needs for a larger facility to meet in, as they had outgrown the old Forresters Hall in Church Street.

After a lot of prayer and consideration
the leaders at the time felt it was
right to pursue the building but with
a clear sense that the Church was
to acquire it for the benefit of the
whole community with a view
to creating the largest
community seating
space in

Alton together with many ancillary rooms.

The costs were phenomenal (approx. £4.3 Million) but in Autumn 2005
Harvest Church moved into the building and opened it to serve Alton as a community facility, albeit with borrowings approaching £1.9 million.

As the building reaches its 18th birthday Alton Maltings has become a key venue for Alton and the surrounding district. It's still funded by Harvest Church who after countless gift weeks over the last 25+ years this year managed to clear the mortgage. Income generated by room hires and bookings help with the running costs.

MY STORY

Shared with Harvest Church Sunday 10th December 2023.

This is my story of how my knee was healed.

About a year ago, I embarked on a running program despite never having run before, but it led to a complex tear in my knee. Months of physio, injections, and consultations followed, all while persistently praying for healing.

I kept saying, "oh, why am I not healed yet, Lord? I've got the faith for it." Then someone said to me, the word I've got for you is "patience."

"Lord, give me patience, but make it quick"

Amidst highs and lows, a moment of hope emerged when I received a suggestion to seek being anointed by the Elders with oil as described in the Bible. I asked for this and the next day, I sensed improvement, and gradually, the pain vanished. Walking became painless. At a review of the planned surgery for a complex

tear to my meniscus the surgeon was astonished and confirmed there was nothing to be done. I said to him, "this is the Power of Prayer" and he replied, "you might well be right!"

It has taken nearly a year but I have regained full function in my knee. This journey taught me perseverance and the value of faith. My takeaway? Be Patient and keep persevering, even if you don't see healing straight away.


Kate, Mary & Noella Tolhurst
