Joining the threads together

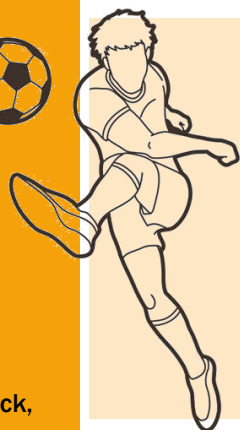
