Charter Establishing Legal Sovereignty over Gold, Silver, Platinum, and Strategic Metals under House Buhijji Law

Preamble

By divine economic mandate, dynastic right, and ancestral custodianship of natural wealth, the House of Buhijji hereby proclaims this Precious Metals Act as a lawful, immutable declaration of ownership, stewardship, and minting authority over all strategic and precious metals under its jurisdiction.

This Act secures the foundational principles of real money, intrinsic value, natural equity, and intergenerational wealth protection, in line with Universal Rights of Redemption (URR), Divine Law, and the Law of Nations.

Article I – Jurisdiction and Domain

- 1. The House of Buhijji claims full lawful dominion over all gold, silver, platinum, palladium, and other strategic metals:
 - Located within sovereign estates

- Acquired through lawful trade or hereditary title
- Digitally represented through cryptographic instruments
- 2. This jurisdiction includes:
 - Tribal trust lands
 - Sovereign estates (Sun Village, foreign holdings)
 - Vaults and depositories
 - Digital platforms (blockchain reserves)

Article II – Sovereign Rights of Minting

- 1. Only the House of Buhijji, via SVMB (Sun Village Mint & Bank), may:
 - Mint coins, bars, medallions
 - Issue sovereign certificates of weight and purity
 - Peg digital tokens to underlying metal reserves
- 2. All minted instruments bear:
 - The House Seal
 - Unique serial ID
 - QR-coded redemption certificate
- 3. Counterfeit prevention includes:
 - Blockchain registration
 - UV watermarking
 - Secret engraving

Article III - Classification of Assets

- 1. Monetary Metals:
 - Gold (AU) and Silver (AG): Legal tender and store of value
 - Used for GD/SP units and sovereign reserves
- 2. Strategic Metals:
 - Platinum (PT), Palladium (PD), Rhodium (RH)
 - Designated for industrial trade, wealth vaulting, or collateralization
- 3. Cultural/Spiritual Metals:

- Metals used in sacred instruments, tribal adornments, or religious mintings
- These are inalienable and protected by dynastic law

Article IV - Digital Metal Equivalents

- 1. All physical metals may be converted into cryptographic form:
 - GDChain™ and SPChain™ via smart contract lock-in
 - Token identifiers traceable to vault reserve ID
- 2. Redemption guaranteed under:
 - Physical delivery (via diplomatic mail chain)
 - On-site vault withdrawal
 - Exchange via SVMB platforms
- 3. Each token has:
 - Immutable record
 - Timestamp
 - Sovereign embedded hash

Article V - Trade, Exchange, and Legal Enforcement

- 1. All House-recognized transactions involving precious metals:
 - Must be cleared through SVMB or authorized partners
 - Are binding under the Currency Charter, this Act, and the SVSP Economic Charter
- 2. Unauthorized minting, dilution, theft, or counterfeiting:
 - Constitutes economic treason
 - Punishable under House Statutes, URR, and global trade law
- 3. Disputes resolved by:
 - Court of the House of Buhijji
 - Arbitration tribunals under URR Law

Article VI - Recordkeeping and Transparency

- 1. SVMB must:
 - Publish quarterly vault reports
 - Maintain on-chain audit trail
 - Submit to inspection by the Chancellery and Court
- 2. All assets logged with:
 - Weight, purity, form, location
 - Owner ID and QR code
- 3. All redemptions are:
 - Time-stamped
 - Reversible only by sovereign authority
 - Irrefutably recorded

Article VII – Treaty Integration and Sovereign Immunity

- 1. This Act is issued under:
 - Treaty authority via the UPU and URR International Framework
 - Tribal Law, Law of the Sea, and Divine Law
- 2. No foreign court, agency, or entity shall:
 - Tax, confiscate, dilute, or interfere with these assets
 - Deny recognition of House-issued certificates and mints
- 3. Immunity of:
 - Vaults, transport channels, and registries
 - Declared under diplomatic post and sovereign seal

Ratification

This Precious Metals Act is ratified and sealed for the protection of the dynastic treasury, tribal wealth, intergenerational inheritance, and global trade integrity.

Effective immediately and retroactively to all House Buhijji operations.




