What is Child Find?

It's a process to "find" children who may have a delay in development or a disability in any of the following areas:

- Vision/Hearing
- Motor Control or Coordination
 - Behavior or Social Skills
 - Speech or Language Skills
 - Thinking or Performing Tasks
 - Adaptive Behavior

Duncan Unified School District is offering **FREE DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENINGS** for children between the ages of 3 years – 5 years old who live in the Duncan Unified School District.

*For Children NOT enrolled in a school based program, including homeschool programs.

What if I am unable to attend? You can contact Bobbie Hansen, Duncan Special Education Support Services at (928) 359-2471 and schedule a screening if you are unable to attend on the scheduled date.

How does Child Find work? If your child is under 3 years old, an Arizona Early Intervention specialist will be able to talk to you about your concerns and observe your child.

For children ages 3 through 5, the Special Education Support Services Team uses screening tools for a quick check of your child's development or performance in the areas that can affect development and learning in school. If a possible delay is suspected then a full evaluation will be scheduled.
