## **Rules/Safety**

### **Firearm Safety-**

- Gun cases are not allowed in the club house area. Firearms should be taken out of the case at your vehicle and leave your gun case in your vehicle. This helps ensure the visibility of your gun being unloaded.
- The action should be open until you are on the fan and ready to shoot. If you have a semi-automatic gun, you are REQUIRED to have a shell catcher on your gun or use a rubber band to prevent the shells from hiding someone. If you do not have either or, you will not be able to shoot. This includes invites.
- ALWAYS point your gun in a safe direction (up towards the sky or down towards the ground) never at people.
- Never load your gun until you are ready to shoot.
- Keep your fingers off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- Pick up any shells/hulls that hit the ground after your shoot is over.

### **Gun checks:**

- On the first night of practice (each year), you must bring your gun with you. Please find a coach to look at the gun to make sure it is free of obstructions and no visible defects.
- Once a gun check has been done, the coach will place a JSC sticker on the gun. This should be the only gun used.
  - If you choose to change your gun for any reason, another gun check will need to be done from a coach, and the new sticker should be put on the gun before it can be used.

### **Eye Protection:**

- Shooting glasses (clear safety glasses or tinted safety glasses) are always required when you are on the fan or when you are at invites near the stand.

### **Hearing Protection:**

- Hearing protection (ear plugs or earmuffs) hearing protection is always required when you are on the fan or when you are at invites near the stand.

### **Other important rules/safety:**

- No horseplay on the fan or in the general area.
- No negative attitudes. This is a team sport and the attitude you share makes it hard for other team members to compete to the best of their ability. No swearing and no throwing around of things on the fan.
- Practice how you want to shoot.
- Coaches have the right to remove any shooters for any reason.
  - Anyone found not following any of SCTP rules, safety rules, or expectations may be asked to leave and not return. No refunds will be given.

### Club Rules:

- No one is allowed behind the counter/bar area without prior permission.
- No one is allowed to go into the back room for any reason without prior permission.
- No horseplay is permitted on the fan or surrounding area.
- Shooting: No shooting to start before 4PM.
  - Extra practice can be done on Mondays AFTER your conference shoot. It must be done with a coach and the score card turned in. Please try to have your practice shooting done by 8pm.
  - Conference shoot is to start no later than 6:30pm. Anyone wanting to participate in the conference shoot after 630pm must have coach approval first.
- Only people allowed on the fan will be coaches and those who are shooting. No friends or family are allowed on the fan.

### Cost:

- \$300 for the first shooter, any other additional youth sibling shooters will be \$200
  - All targets for the season for mandatory practices, conference scores, and invites.
  - Includes two cases (20 boxes of rounds)
  - Fees paid for invites you sign up for and conference shoot.
  - Includes membership of the SCTP.
  - Includes membership in the ATA (if applicable)
  - Includes JSC yearly youth membership.

New athletes will receive a Jersey with sign-up. Any future sign-up costs will not include another jersey. This will be reviewed yearly and can be changed at any time.

### Fundraising:

- Fundraising is one way we can keep the entry fee lower than many teams around us. Participation in fundraising is required. The following fundraisers are done each year.
  - **PIZZA**
    - Each year the JSC Youth Trap Team does a pizza fundraiser to help cover the cost of many things.
    - Information on the pizza sales will be provided during the sign-up meeting or shortly after.
    - Each shooter is encouraged to participate in the pizza sale with a minimum goal of selling \$300.00.
    - Prizes for at least the top three sellers

- **JSC Youth Trap Annual Raffle**

- This raffle consists of many different prizes- guns, gift certificates, cash, ect.
- Tickets are \$20 each and all shooters are asked to sell at least 10.
- Information will be provided during one of the Monday night shoots.

- **Monday Night Dinners**

- These dinners are put on by parent volunteers. The cost of the dinners will be \$6, this includes the dinner and a soda/water.

### **Sponsorships**

- Another way to help keep the cost of joining the team is to help find sponsorships. Any business that sponsors the JSC Youth Trap Team will be recognized on the JSC Youth Trap Team Facebook page. The funds raised from the sponsorship helps towards the purchase of the ammo you receive, the invites that must be paid for, team fees, and many other tasks that require funds. ### **Expectations**

- **This is a team sport! We shoot as a team.**
  - Be on time!
  - Arrive 30 minutes before scheduled shoot time for invites. You will receive an email beforehand letting you know your shoot time and what time you should arrive. Figure in travel time, slow traffic, and other unforeseen circumstances that may arise to prevent you from being late.
  - If you sign up for an invitation and you do not attend, you will be responsible for paying the club back for the cost of the invite(s) that you miss.
  - **Athletes and parents are expected to treat our trap shooting coaches with respect and appreciation. These coaches are volunteers who generously give their time to help athletes learn, grow, and stay safe. A positive attitude and good sportsmanship from everyone makes the experience better for the entire team.**

- **Attendance**

- We will practice and shoot our conference scores in the rain, snow, cold, ect. The ONLY time we will cancel is for extreme cold or lightning.
- We expect you to participate in EVERY Monday practice and EVERY Monday conference scored shoot.
- Practice is at JSC on Mondays unless otherwise noted and will start NO sooner than 4pm.
- Please try and be done with practice at 8pm on Mondays
- Practice for NEW shooters starts on February 23rd, Practice for returning shooters starts on March 2nd. Conference shoots begin on March 23rd.
- If you are sick you are not able to attend you will not be able to make this up. The ONLY time you can shoot ahead is the week of your Spring Break. If you are planning on being gone on Monday for your Spring Break please see the head coach to make arrangements.

### **Conference shoots:**

- Will be at JSC starting NO sooner than 4pm on Mondays. 6:30pm is the LATEST time a shooter can start a conference shoot. Anyone wanting to participate in the conference shoot after 6:30pm must have the head coach approve it first. Please keep in mind the coaches are volunteers.
- Practice shooting AFTER a conference shoot is acceptable. All shooting must be done by 8pm and you must have a coach out on the pad with you.
- If you miss any conference shoots on Monday, you will NOT be able to medal out at the year-end conference shoot.
- Immediately after your squad finishes, you must leave the fan, but before you leave the shooting area, you as a squad must check in with your coach for any reminders, tips, or vital information that we may need to pass on. After you check in with your coach, you are free to leave.
- Please watch the monitor in JSC for vital information.
- Participating in Jefferson Youth Trap is no different than participating in any other sport or organized event. If you sign up for the commitment, our expectations are that you will show up for all practices, Monday night conference shoots, and the year-end conference shoot in June at the Waukesha Gun Club.
- Practicing outside of Monday is encouraged. JSC has open shooting on Sundays. Waukesha Gun Club is another wonderful place to practice trap, skeet, and sporting clays.

## Responsibilities:

- It is the responsibility of each shooter to ensure they have everything they need for the shoot, not limited to:
  - Your firearm/shotgun
  - Safety glasses
  - Hearing protection
  - Ammo
  - Shooting vest or shell pouch
  - Jersey for invites
  - Appropriate attire for invites:
    - No sandals or open-toed shoes
    - No short shorts
    - No sleeveless tops
    - Jersey:
      - The JSC Youth Trap Team jersey will be **required** to wear to every invite.
      - When you are at Nationals in Ohio, the jersey will only be required to be worn on scheduled trap shoot days.
      - If you do not have your jersey (just like any other sport), you will not be able to shoot and will need to refund the team for the cost of the shoot.
    - Know your shoot time.
    - Know your shooting location.
    - Have Spares of Ear plugs, safety glasses, and ammo.
- It is also the responsibility of both the athlete and their parents to keep the head coach informed of any failing grades. Athletes with failing grades are not permitted to shoot and are held to the same academic eligibility standards as all other school sports.

## Important Dates:

- February 2nd- NEW shooter Meeting at 6pm
- February 7th- Mandatory Sign-Up meeting at 9am or 10am
- **February 16th- Last day to sign up at JSC between 6p-7p- no exceptions.**
- February 23rd (NEW SHOOTERS) first night of practice 4pm. Please bring only your gun.
- March 2nd- ALL SHOOTERS practice (Outdoor) at 4pm or later (no later than 630pm). Please bring your gun, ammo, ear plugs, vest/shell pouches, and safety glasses.
- March 9<sup>th</sup>, All shooters practice – 4pm or later (no later than 630pm) (Let Matt know if you are shooting the week ahead for your spring break week)
- March 16<sup>th</sup> ALL shooters practice together- 4pm (no later than 630pm).



- March 23rd- 4pm (no later than 630pm) through May 11th. Weekly Conference scores start.
  - These will be on Monday nights at JSC.
  - Fifty targets each night
  - You can shoot practice rounds AFTER your 50 round conference shoots. These MUST be done with a coach and a score sheet turned in.
  - March 30th- Is the LAST day to sign up for all Invites.
- April 30th- LAST day to sign up for National in Marengo, Ohio July 11th-19th
- June 1st- Nationals Meeting at 5:30pm

### **Other Important Dates:**

- March 9th, (Monday)- Pizza order forms are due.
- March 16th, (Monday)- 73<sup>rd</sup> Annual Wisconservation Club Banquet. We are looking to have 10-15 of our team members volunteer from 5pm to approx. 9pm. You would be assisting with passing out food and passing out raffle prizes to the winners. Please use the sign-up to volunteer! The deadline to sign up is Monday March 2nd. If you sign up, please plan to be at the club for your conference shoot at 4pm so you can shoot and get to the Banquet. It is at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds: 503 N Jackson Ave in Jefferson.
- March 23rd-May 11th Conference Shoots
- April 6th, (Monday)- Pizza order pick-up
- April 13th, (Monday)- Pizza Party
- June 29th, - End of Year party- Everyone that shoots at any invites will receive all rewards and patches on this night that they earned. We welcome everyone to have some food and cake and cheer on everyone's accomplishment this season.

*\*\*\* There is a possibility that more invites will be added. We will send out emails informing you of these updates as soon as we know the dates and location.*

Please keep in mind we have many shooters that participate in the invites, if there is an invite that you sign up for and don't have a ride for the shooter, please reach out to other families someone will have room and would be happy to help out.

You can check scores at [app.sssfonline.com/results](http://app.sssfonline.com/results). Go to the bottom and click on SCTP, Enter Team name-Jefferson Sportsmens Club and then search. Then you can go to Shoots or conferences and look up scores. Please keep in mind when checking your shooters scores some shoots are multiple days and final results will not be in until the shoot is complete. If you have any questions on how to look scores up please ask Jeni.

**\*\*Please take note, the sign-up sheets for the invites are on the counter. Please sign up for those that you know you can attend.**

**The latest date to sign up for ANY invite is MONDAY MARCH 30<sup>st</sup>, 2026.**

After this date, no one will be added to any of the invites. Please make sure you sign up for the ones you can commit to. If there happens to be an invite that you didn't sign up for and would like to attend, you can join a wait list to see if there are any cancellations. This does not include Nationals. We will post a date for Nationals later.

Once you are signed up and it is past the date above, and cannot make the invite, you will be responsible for paying the club back the dues unless a replacement athlete can be found.
