Hello! My name is Brian Kimbrough and I am originally from Russellville Alabama. I just celebrated my six month milestone as resident at The Remnant House. My life began in chaos as my mother passed away at just six years old, leaving me to live with my father who was a drug user and dealer. He was abusive and mean to me my whole childhood. The only time life seemed close to normal was when I would stay at my grandparent's homes. They tried as hard as they knew how to give me a good life and to make up for me losing my mother at such a young age. As i got older I began to manipulate their good and giving nature to enable my drug use and addiction lifestyle. My mother was also a drug addict and passed away as a result. I remember my father's mom telling me that if I didn't stop doing drugs I would end up in prison, which came true when I was 23 years old when I served three and half years in the Alabama Department of Corrections. When I got home from prison I met my second wife and started going to church with her and for the first time in my life got sort of close to God, as best I knew at the time. I was going to church on and off for a few years but never fully surrendered to God. I would go back and forth between serving God and messing up. I did a couple faith-based programs throughout the years but would always go back to my hometown which was my Egypt. Finally in 2023 I was done and knew I needed to do something different so I reached out to Donovan on Facebook and he sent me to Victory Mission Bible Training Center in Arkansas where I completed their eight month residential program and then came to live at The Remnant House. Now I live a life I never thought possible, God has healed me supernaturally from having hepatitis-C, I have a job i enjoy and I walk with God everyday and I'm truly happy. I am so grateful to the Remnant House and to all of you for your continued support both financially and in prayer. The work you are helping facilitate here is changing lives for generations to come!

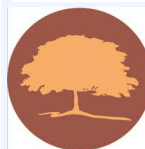
We are deeply grateful for the incredible support from our community. Each gift is a visible reminder that God provides through His people, and together we are building a place where hope gets rebuilt.
